Ava is an excellent role model for her peers. She is always excited about learning and shows a positive attitude in everything she does. Ava is a kind friend to all.



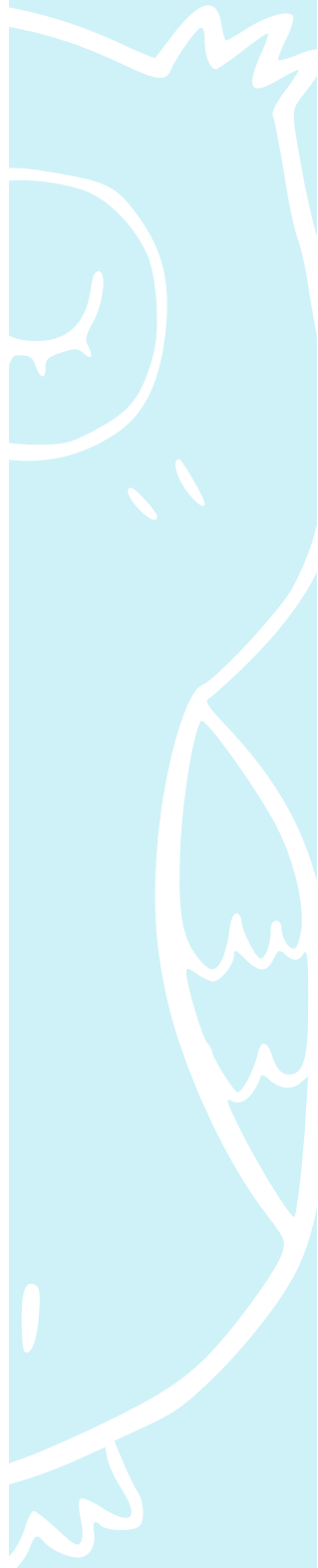
**Grace McDermott**

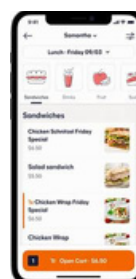
