From the Principal



Library News - BOOK WEEK 2025


Hello again from the library. It's hard to believe we are almost halfway through the year!

We're thrilled to offer a fantastic opportunity for junior hockey players aged 5–12 to take part in a Hockey NSW-facilitated school holiday skills clinic!


Date: Tuesday, 15th July **Time:** 10:00 AM - 1:00 PM
